To run for School Board, you must be a registered voter in the district in which you are running. You must register your campaign in the Secretary of State's <u>campaign finance system</u> and submit your <u>declaration of candidacy</u> form on August 29th. That's it! For Santa Fe City Council you must <u>gather signatures</u> but will need less than 100 to qualify.
